

Historic desk regain

The Fort Edward Historical Association has purchased a mahogany "campaign desk" thought to have belonged to Revolutionary War hero Philip Schuyler — for whom Schuylerville is named.

"It could be as old as 1770," said Paul McCarty, who heads the historical association, which

operates the Old Fort House Museum in Fort Edward.

"This is our 60th anniversary. To have found this — it's a coup for Fort Edward. It's a coup for the entire area really."

The desk long belonged to Fort Edward descendants of Abraham Wing, the original settler of Glens Falls, but Mr. McCarty said it ended up in Alabama when Wing's great great great grand-
