## Surfside's \$10-million upgrade

As Surfside on the Lake owner Salim Amersi saw it, with Dave Kenny's new Mariott Courtyard Hotel soon to open across the street and with some of his own lodging rooms showing their age, he reached the point where "it was either hang my hat or do the investment."

Thus, a \$10-million upgrade to the Surfside at 400 Canada Street in Lake George Village is nearing completion.

Work is still under way, but it will open "very, very, very soon," Mr. Amersi said on a Chronicle tour of the building May 30.

"Basically, the whole thing we're trying to do, my wife [Moech] and myself, if we were going to do this investment, was to do something really special," Mr. Amersi said. "We put our hearts into this project, you know, with fine details, quality

finishes....It's a long-term investment, but it will pay off."

"The amount of money we put in here, I could've bought three motels...but running one place is enough work as it is," he added with a laugh. Mr. Amersi added, "It's not all about money, it's also a bit of a passion, you know."

Mr. Amersi, originally from the Congo in Africa, has owned the Surfside since 1983.
