Lake George compound for sale: \$10.5-million

A 2.43-acre compound with five year-round homes, 212 feet of Lake George shoreline, and a 1,000-square-foot Adirondack-style "entertainment" building with a stone fireplace, is listed for sale by the Sherwood Group for \$10.5-million.

Listing agent Lonnie Lawrence declined comment when contacted. Sherwood's Website touts:

'Colony Cove': 5 homes, 212 feet of lakefront

"When entering the private gated compound at Cromwell Manor, the era of the 'Great and Gracious' has been recreated on the west side of Lake George," just

north of the Depe Dene Resort at Diamond Point on Lakeshore Drive on the lake's west side.

"Included in this stunning residential and/or corporate compound are five quality designed and constructed year-round homes, comprising...10,500 square feet of living space and 18 bedrooms" and 14.5 bathrooms.
