

Her goal in Pacific: Find WW2 remains

Editor's note: Terry Waterston of North Creek phoned last week to alert us that her granddaughter Mackenzie Waterston, 20, of Glens Falls was on her way to the World War II Pacific battle site of Saipan in the Mariana Islands in a group searching for remains of soldiers killed there.

Mackenzie, a SUNY Adirondack student who graduated in 2012 from Glens Falls High School, interned this summer with the New York State Military Museum in Saratoga Springs. There she met and assisted members of Kuentai-USA, a non-profit group that searches for war dead.
