Wave Park soon on the Sacandaga

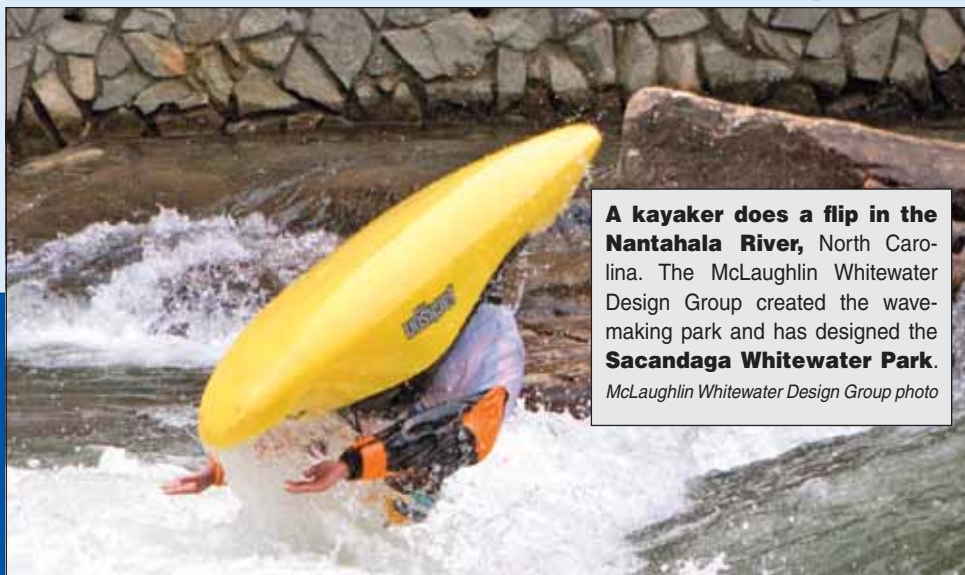

Construction will start next spring of the long-planned Sacandaga Whitewater Park between Lake Luzerne and Hadley, creating the first of three whitewater channels for kayakers, surfers and boogie boarders.

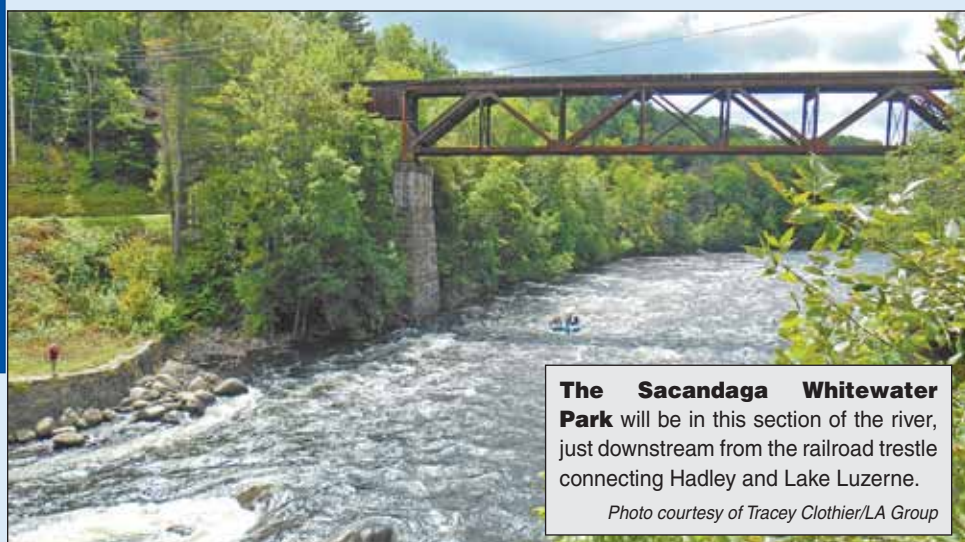
Large boulders will be strategically placed in the Sacandaga River just downstream from the railroad trestle, creating "a wave not unlike an ocean wave," said John Duncan, owner of the Sacandaga Outdoor Center and a member of the not-for-profit
