Falcons in Glens Falls

There has been a nesting pair of peregrine falcons within the Glens Falls city limits for the last 12 years. Mona Bearor of the Southern Adirondack Audubon Society has monitored the nest for six years for the State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC).

Nesting peregrines thriving at rooftop & under radar

Perhaps you've seen a falcon perched on a downtown building, looking for a wayward pigeon, as a *Chronicle* reporter has.

"Someone saw one on top of the Travelers building, and another person I know has seen them on the Cronin High Rise building," Ms. Bearor said. "I look every time I go through Glens Falls."

To protect the falcons, *The Chronicle* agreed not to divulge the location of the nest.

First discovered in 2002, the same male and female produced healthy chicks until the male was killed in 2011, hitting a wire while flying (they can get up to speeds of

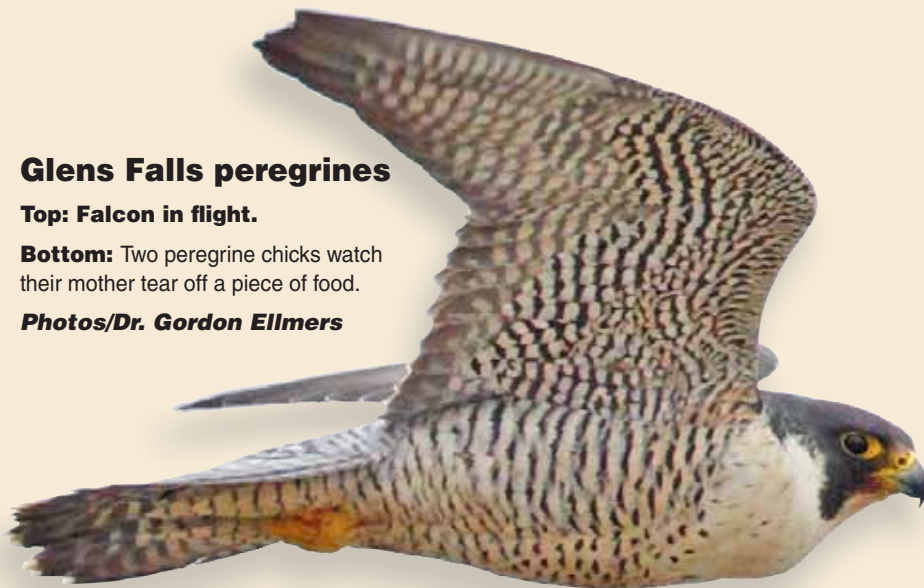
