

NYS OKs North Creek plan for NY Ski Museum

The group seeking to create the New York Museum of Skiing and Ski Hall of Fame in North Creek has been granted a five-year "provisional charter" by the New York

State Board of Regents. "This is a big step," Dr. Dan O'Keeffe of **Glens Falls** told The Chronicle.

'Big step' but a long way to go to achieve it

"Now we can really start to get things going."

But Robert Nessle, the group's interim chair, cautioned that "we're very much in the beginning stages" and it could potentially take as long as 10 or 20 years before the museum opens.

Mr. Nessle said that, with the charter, "we have something that gives our organization some credibility" allowing them to ap-
