O.P. Frederick's has been a Loon Lake staple in the Town of Chester for 23 years.

This spring, retired State Trooper George Stannard and Minerva school teacher Bruce Hodgson bought it from founders Bob and Vivian Frederick.

cozy bar where you get the feeling everyone knows everyone.

Cook Ray Dower was the first person hired by Mr. Frederick back in 1992 and he's still there 23 years later. Head chef Ed Benham is in his sixth year.

second-floor sleeping porches, five bathrooms and an original stone fireplace. There's also 338 feet of lakefront, a renovated 2-bedroom guest house,


