The Kiwanis Club of Glens Falls Community Service Budget last year was approximately \$82,000.

That's raised by three major events: The annual Duck Race and Family Festival at Haviland's Cove in July, a Golf Tournament in August — and Taste of the North Country in September.

"Taste" typically accounts for half of the club's fund-raising. That money is distributed to nonprofits, individuals and organizations all year.
