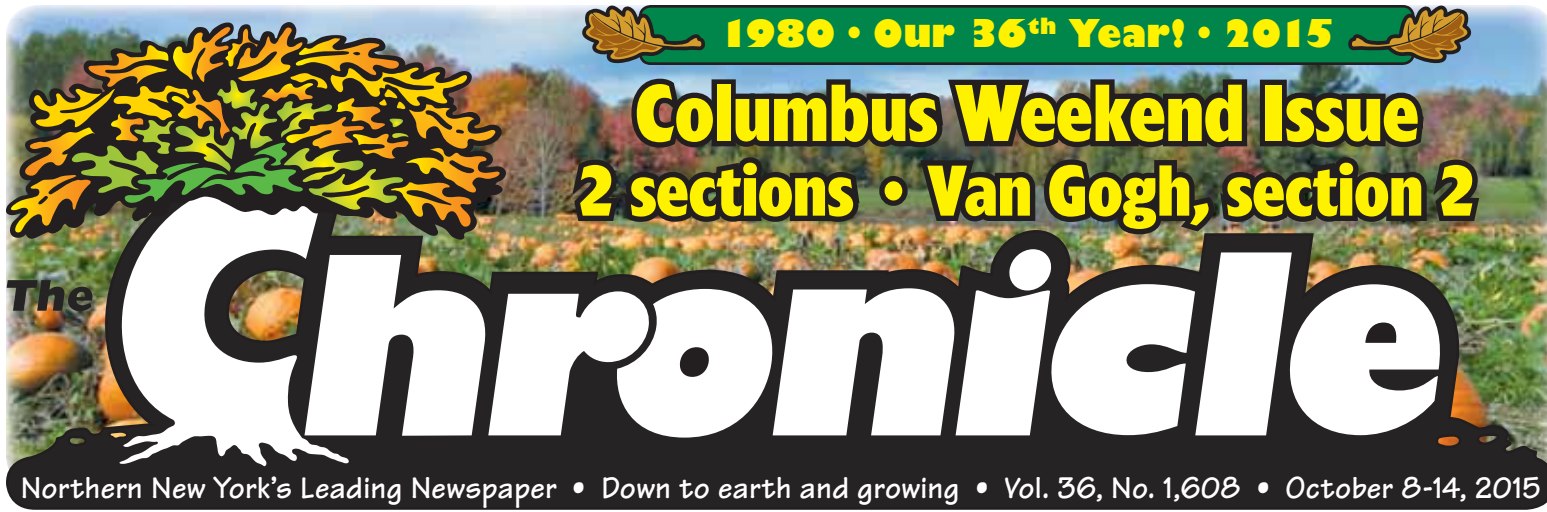

Remarkably few people have swum — or even tried to swim — the length of Lake George. Bob Singer wants to change that.

Inspired by the past summer's remembrances of Diane Struble's feat in 1958, when the 24-year-old single mother of three became the first person to swim the lake's 32 miles, Mr. Singer seeks to enlist swimmers to attempt the feat — either individually or as part of a relay — on Sept. 17, 2016.

"I think Lake George could use a signature restaurant," Dave Kenny tells *The Chronicle*, and he thinks the six-story, \$25-million Marriott Courtyard Hotel he's building on Canada Street just south of the high school would be a perfect place for it.
