Israelis see doom in '2-state solution'

Israel is under intense and ever increasing global pressure to accept a "Two-State Solution" that would establish a Palestinian state adjacent to Israel.

The Two-State approach has

the backing of Democrats and Republicans, Europe and the U.S., Russia, China, the United Nations and Middle East nations.



Israel is largely isolated, seen as the illegal occupier of Palestinian territory and deemed a villain by much of the world.

But what we found on our family's two-week trip to Israel and Jordan in January is that many — if not most — Israelis see the "Two-State" approach not as a solution but as an act of suicide.

The people expressing this view — who included both the Jewish guides we hired via Internet, as
