Tracking NY's moose by air

New York State is tracking its moose population by air as well as on land.

"For two winters we've done aerial surveys all over the Adirondack Park," counting both moose and their smaller cousins, whitetail deer, as part of an ongoing, multi-year study in New York, Ed Reed, DEC Region 5 wildlife manager, tells *The Chronicle*.

Much remains unknown about moose, the largest land animal in New York State.

Moose were extirpated in New York by the 1860s, but they've been coming back on their own, moving in from surrounding areas, at least since the 1980s, says DEC's moose website,

DEC biologists estimated in 2010 that there were 500 to 800 moose in New York.

Current population data is being sought, with the goal of creating a moose management plan. The study is a joint effort
