
Queensbury developer Rich Schermerhorn is a huge Donald Trump sup-

Medical marijuana legal but so hard to come by

Eleven-year-old Allison Hoffer of Queensbury suffers from Lennox-Gastaut syndrome (LGS),

a type of epilepsy that causes hard-totreat seizures and often impairs development.

Her mother Ellen says that up until a few weeks ago, Allison was non-verbal,

had up to 180 seizures a day and had a three-year-old's level of development.

But two months after starting to use medical marijuana through the New York State Compassionate Care Act, Allison's mother says, "We found a miracle." She says some days Allison has no seizures. Most days she has fewer than 10. "It's nothing like it used to be," Ellen says.

"She woke up. That's the best way to describe it. She has started speaking. She said Mommy today. That was pretty awesome. She is making choices about
