"I'm delighted. This is the first one I've ever been able to buy," he said.

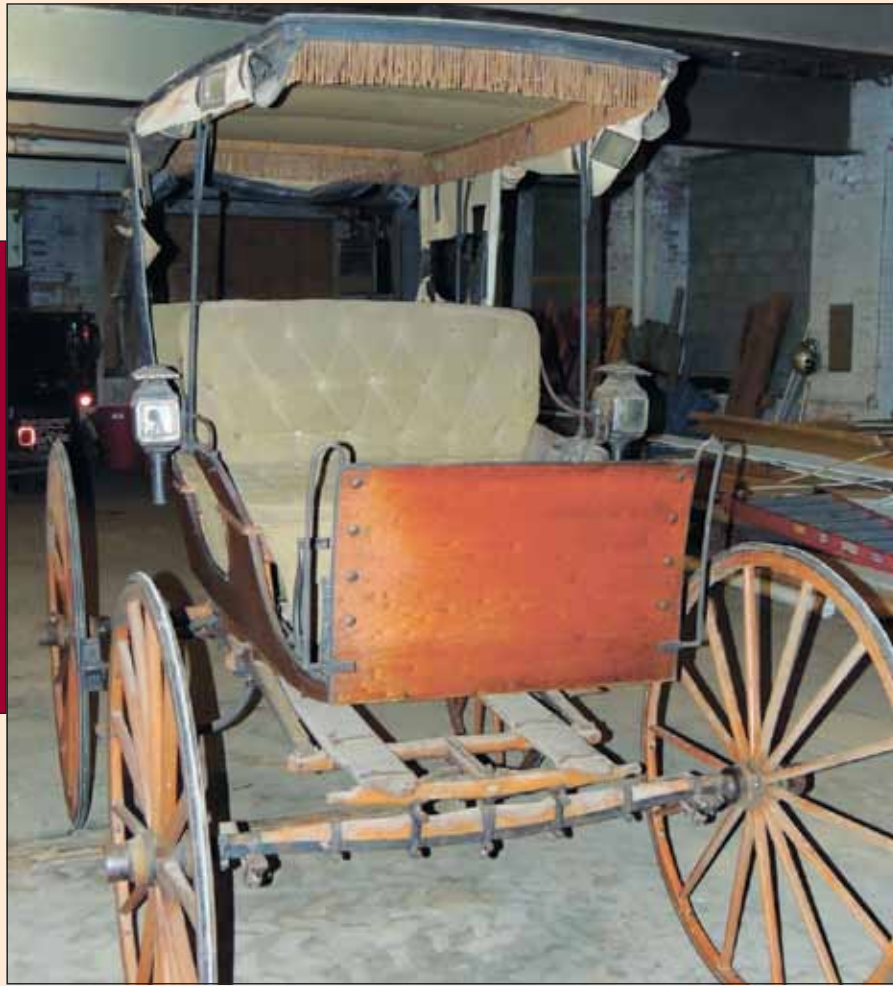
"I'm not a collector, but I do love to bring things home.

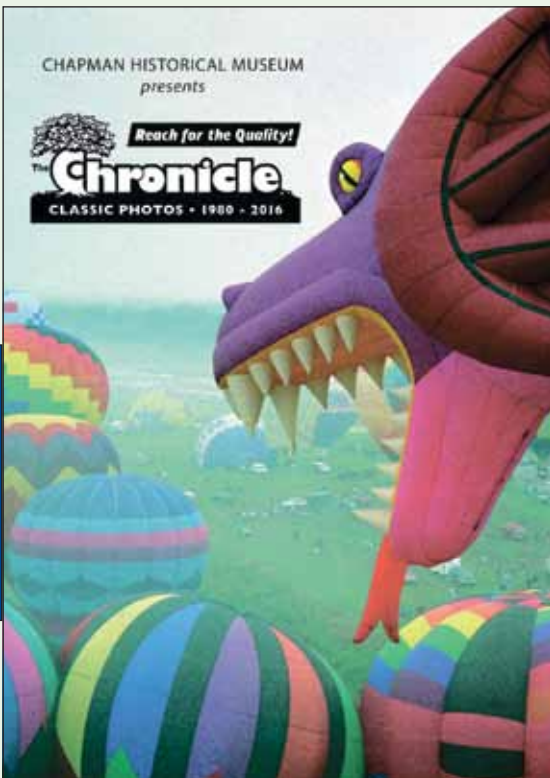
