Moreau Lake State Park has six cedar cabins under construction on the eastern edge of the park that, for the first time, will

allow for yearround camping. Also for the first time. some will allow people to bring their dogs along.

"People are so excited," said Park Manager Peter Iskenderian in reply to a Chronicle inquiry.

He said the cabins will "be ready for rental in May."

set yet. "We're still figuring that out," but he said off-season they'll be \$40 a night for the 4-person cabins and \$60 a night for the 6-person cabins.

Like the three existing cabins at Moreau Lake State Park, these will be available "by the week only" from the "first week in May to Columbus Day, when they're in very high demand, said Mr. Iskederian.
