He said he has told some to do what he said he did, which was "take my copy and bring it back

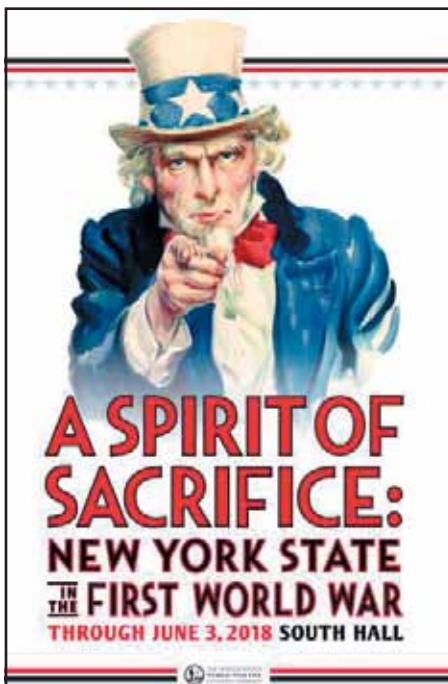

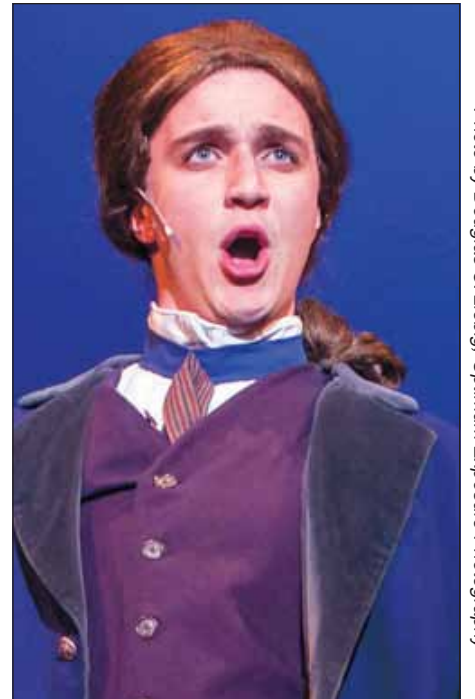
