

Aftermath of horrific dog attack

June 28 last year was not the best day for **Cheyenne Robinson**.

The Queensbury grad, then just 20 years old, was getting ready for work in her Glens Falls apartment, upstairs in the two-family house her father Jim Robinson owns on Wilmot Street.

"It was 6:30 on the morning. I'd just gotten out of the shower," says Cheyenne.

Her long-time boyfriend Cody Pratt was just leaving the room.

Their dog Becker, adopted about three months earlier, was on the bed.

"I put my towel down and went to pet him," says Cheyenne. "I

don't know why — he lunged and grabbed my face from the bed and kind of shook me. He fell — and that's when the piece of my nose ripped off I think. I didn't know it happened."

Ripped part of nose off

"I was screaming, 'Becker, stop!' and just screaming. I fell down on the floor."

To demonstrate, Cheyenne puts

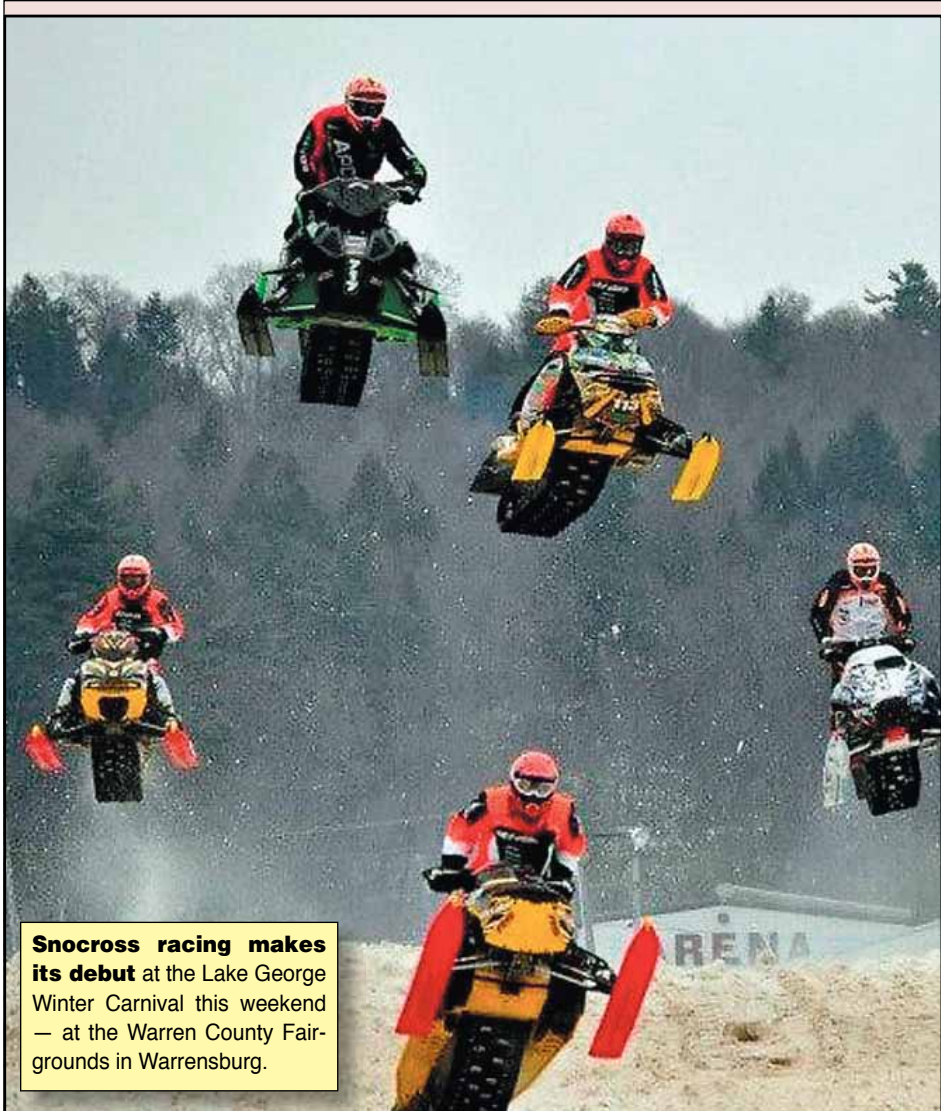

Carnival adds Snocross in Wbg

The Lake George Winter Carnival adds a new twist, and Warrensburg will be seeing some major snowmobile action this weekend, when the East Coast Snocross Conx2share series makes a stop at the Warren County Fairgrounds for rounds five and six of their 2018 schedule on Saturday and Sunday, Feb. 10-11.

Snocross racing features high-performance snowmobiles on a tight course, moving at high speeds with big-air jumps and banked turns.

The event is presented by the Lake George Winter Carnival, held at the fairgrounds due to space requirements.

East Coast Snocross is 13 years old, but its roots date back to the early 90's, and organizations like the World Snowmobile Association and Rock Maple Racing. The

Snowmobile season back in full swing!

About 150 miles of snowmobile trails re-opened Tuesday after Sunday's larger-than-expected snowstorm. More trails were set for opening with Wednesday's predicted storm.

"This is just what the doctor ordered," said Mike Zilm, executive director of the 650-member South Warren Snowmobile Club.

Monday morning he was out with Jeff Baertschi, grooming the Berry Pond loop in Lake Luzerne, part of the 100 miles of trails the club maintains.

"We got about a foot of snow up here," Mr. Zilm said. "It's going to be nice once we get everything groomed...Trails will be incredible by the end of the week."
