Nick Perrone is a one-man maple syrup-making operation, tapping about 500 trees on and near his family's land high up on Truesdale Hill Road in Lake George.

The Warren County Highway Department employee — and 2014 Warrensburg High grad — is a first-generation maple producer.

"Our neighbor John Farrar does maple syrup [Farrar's Maple Products] and sells Christmas trees, and my father brought me down there when I was 5 or 6," Nick said. "He gave us a tour of the sugar house and has been a mentor to me."

Ten years later, in 2012, "I hung six buckets on trees up here, boiled the sap with a homemade evaporator, and made maybe a pint of syrup. I
