# Why not a Lyme vaccine

With Lyme Disease still raging, I'm sure many people ask the same question that occurs to my wife and me when our two dogs get their Lyme preventive vaccine.

**There was one; 500,000 people got the shot; erupting scares killed it**

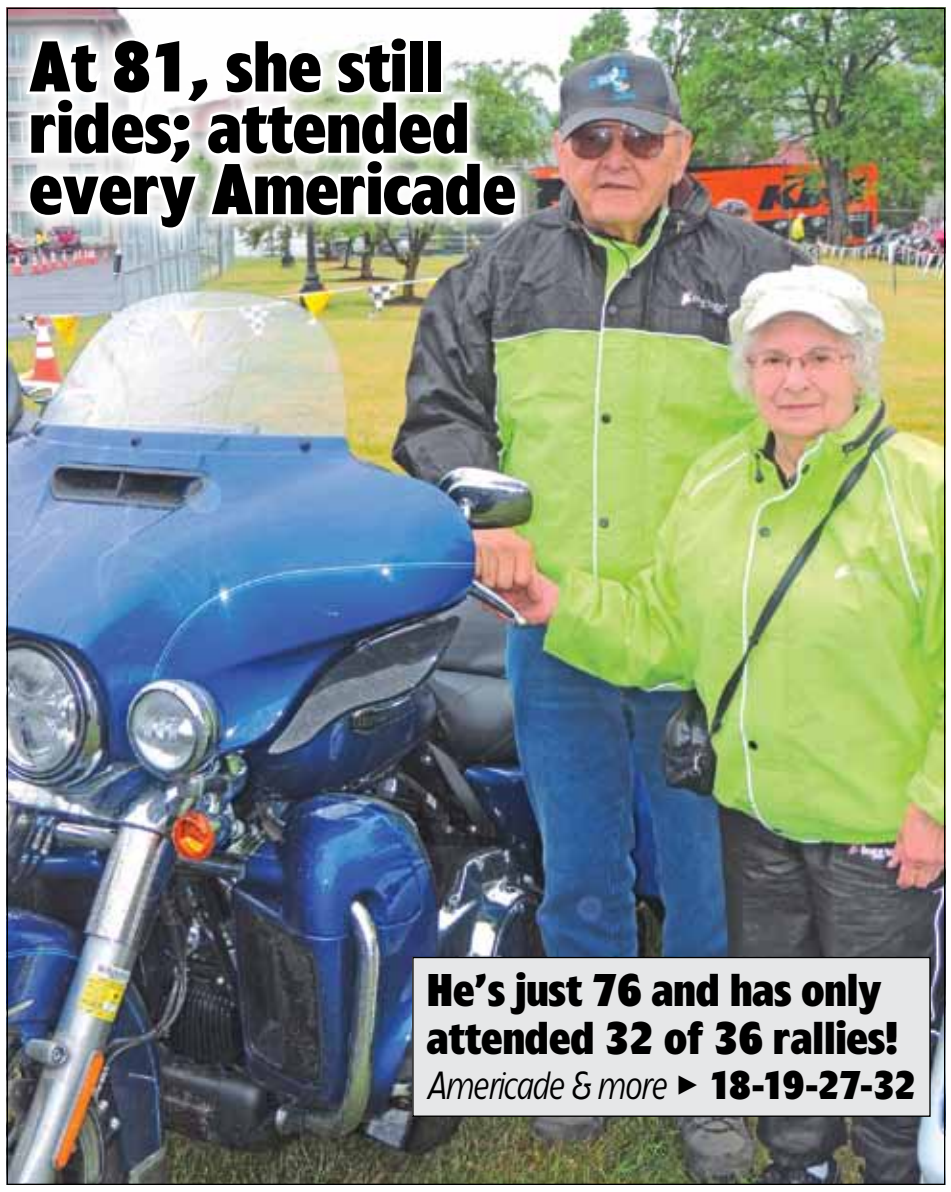
Why no vaccine for humans? Turns out there was one, and in the late 1990s, "hundreds of thousands of people got it — until vaccine fear knocked it off the market," says a May 8 article by a reporter named Brian Resnick on Vox, the news and opinion website owned by Vox Media.

The story's point of view is very favorable toward the vaccine. It said LYMERix, made by Smith-Kline Beecham, was deemed "effective, preventing Lyme in up to 90 percent of the people who were vaccinated with all three doses, with few side effects."

Vox said the Food and Drug Administration approved its use unanimously.

Drawbacks, said the Vox article, included that people needed three separate doses, at \$50
