Argyle launch: Organic creamery

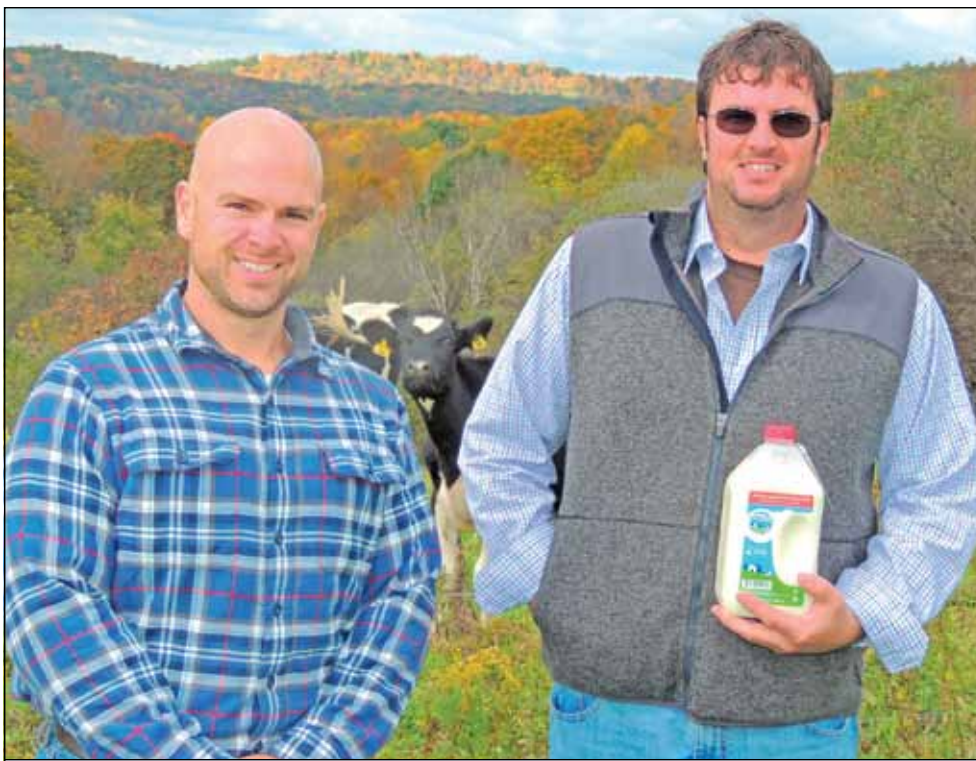
