Chronicle editor Mark Frost writes: The star-studded "comedy drama" is getting mediocre reviews. International Film Magazine *Sight & Sound* opines: "Steve Soderbergh's try-hard muckraking comedy pits Gary Oldman and Antonio Banderas's smarmy Panama Papers frontmen against Meryl Streep's speechifying financial innocent. Nice try, but no cigar."

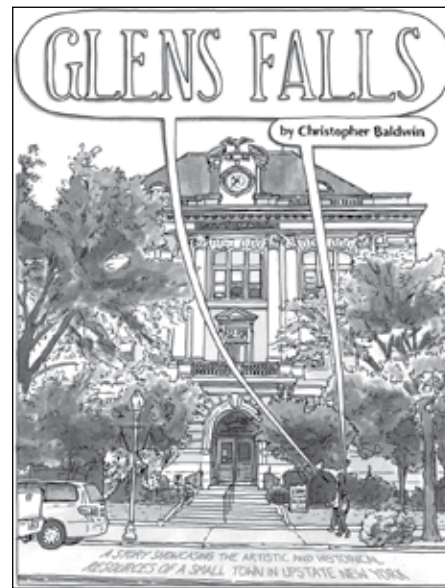
