Couple sets new eatery at Tallulah

Chef Brian Bowden and his wife Carly Mankouski have leased the former Tallulah's restaurant on Ridge Street in Glens Falls. They plan to open Radici Kitchen & Bar, "hopefully in early January or at least mid-January."

Radici means "roots" in Italian, Ms. Mankouski explained.

"It's about circling back to our roots, what we love most, about our passion for this industry," said Mr.

"It's about us putting down roots for the first time together," said Ms. Mankouski.

Radici will seat 50 and serve an "Italian-modern" but "wide-ranging" menu.

They said they'll also have 14 taps including a dozen craft beers; and full wine, liquor service and craft cocktails, once they obtain their liquor license.

They plan to operate six days a week, closed Mondays, with

Sunday brunch and maybe a classic Italian-style Sunday dinner.

"We have so many ideas," the couple said.

They met about 10 years ago at the Ginger Man Restaurant in Albany, where Mr. Bowden was in the kitchen and Ms. Mankouski was front of house.

It's a partnership they've repeated at several restaurants over the years, though this is the

Dan Stec to run for NYS Senate; Braymer, Beaty & Simpson mull Assembly run

As expected, Republican Assemblyman Dan Stec will seek the State Senate seat being vacated by Betty Little, starting a bipartisan scramble for his 114th Assembly district seat.

"Yes, I will be running for the 45th State Senate seat," Mr. Stec told *The Chronicle*, acknowledging "some level of anticipation that this is the next office for me."

Clinton County Treasurer **Kimberly Davis**, a Democrat, had already announced that she will seek Sen. Little's seat.
