Baptist Church sale falls through

The proposed sale of the Glens Falls Baptist Church to an Albany-based drug treatment organization has fallen through, but the church buildings on Maple Street

remain on the market for \$1.414-million.

Dave Fisher, who chairs the church's board of trustees, sent a letter to members last week explaining what has happened since we first broke the story last October.

Opiate treatment center pursues different location

The Chronicle obtained a copy of the letter, which says the unnamed not-for-profit drug treatment organization planned to buy the buildings, renovate the church school into an in-patient treatment center for men dealing with opioid addiction, and lease the sanctuary back to the church.

The letter says the not-forprofit, which we have learned is Addictions Care Center of Albany, pursued purchasing the church after another possible purchase fell through. Addictions Care Center just opened a residential




Megan Schlinger to wed Donnie Long
