

Hospital testing for COVID-19: Get doctor's order

Local testing for COVID-19 is taking place at Glens Falls Hospital only.

Patients must have a referral

from their primary care physician to get tested, said hospital vice president Ray Agnew.

"All patients arriving for testing should go to the Emergency Department COVID-19 testing ramp, located directly outside the Glens Falls Hospital Emergency Department. Please do not go to the main entrance of Glens Falls Hospital. The testing trailer will be open daily from 8
