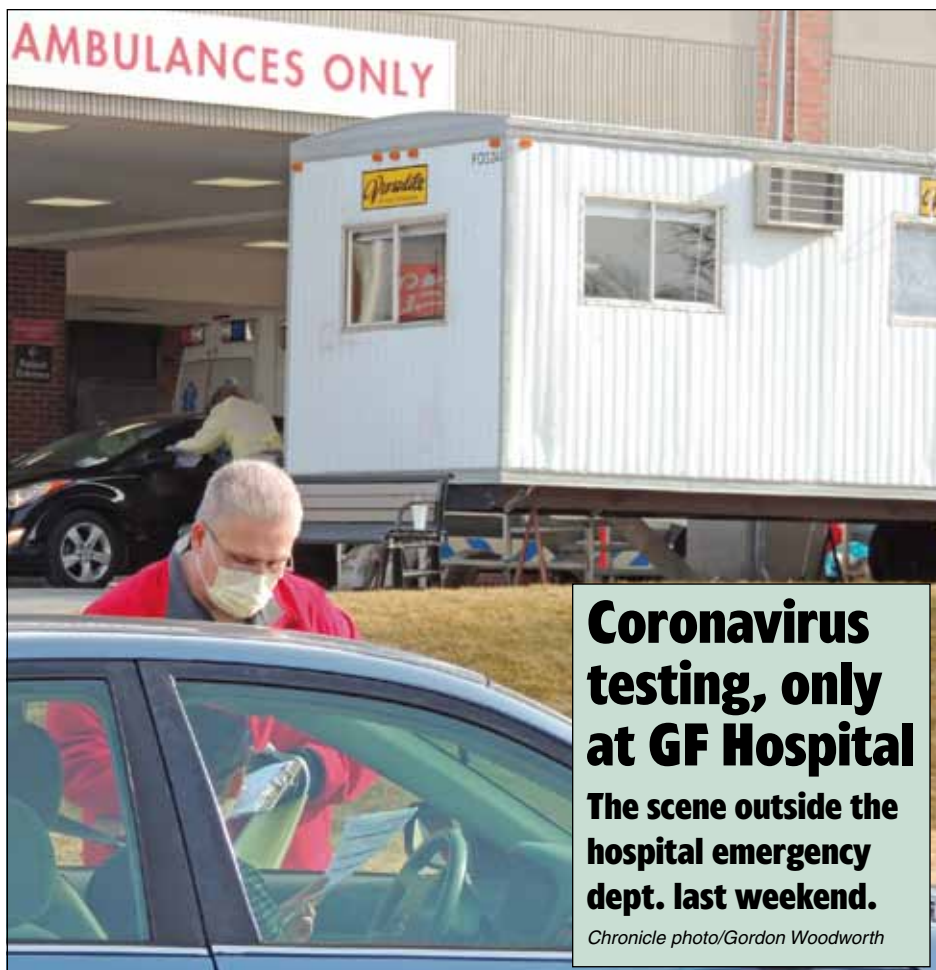
"I anticipate we will have the capacity to surge like we need to, with the medical staff, the nursing staff..." Dr. Bain told *The Chronicle* Sunday.

Hospital testing for COVID-19: Get doctor's order

Local testing for COVID-19 is taking place at Glens Falls Hospital only.

Patients must have a referral

from their primary care physician to get tested, said hospital vice president Ray Agnew.

"All patients arriving for testing should **go to the Emergency Department COVID-19 testing ramp**, located directly outside the Glens Falls Hospital Emergency Department. Please do not go to the main entrance of Glens Falls Hospital. The testing trailer will be open daily from 8
