Tornado it was in GF-Luzerne


The National Weather Service confirmed that a grade one tornado touched down and ran an 8.6-mile path from Call Street, Lake Luzerne, to Ridge Street, Glens Falls on Friday, March 29, from 5:52 to 6:05 p.m.

Its maximum width was "433 yards or about 1/4 mile," and its estimated maximum wind speed was 75 to 110 miles per hour, the 2nd lowest category of tornado.

There were no known injuries or fatalities. Many trees were damaged or uprooted.

"The tornado touched down near the Hudson River close to Hawk Road south of Call Street."

Phase 2 OK
