Mark Faille, who in the past decade has become a major farm presence in Washington County raising "100% grass-fed beef and

pasture-raised pork," last Friday bought the 197-acre Pole Valley golf course in the Town of

Dylan told *The Chronicle* in a phone interview Sunday evening, "It's really touching how people appreciate that we're keeping it a course, to see how relieved and happy they are."
