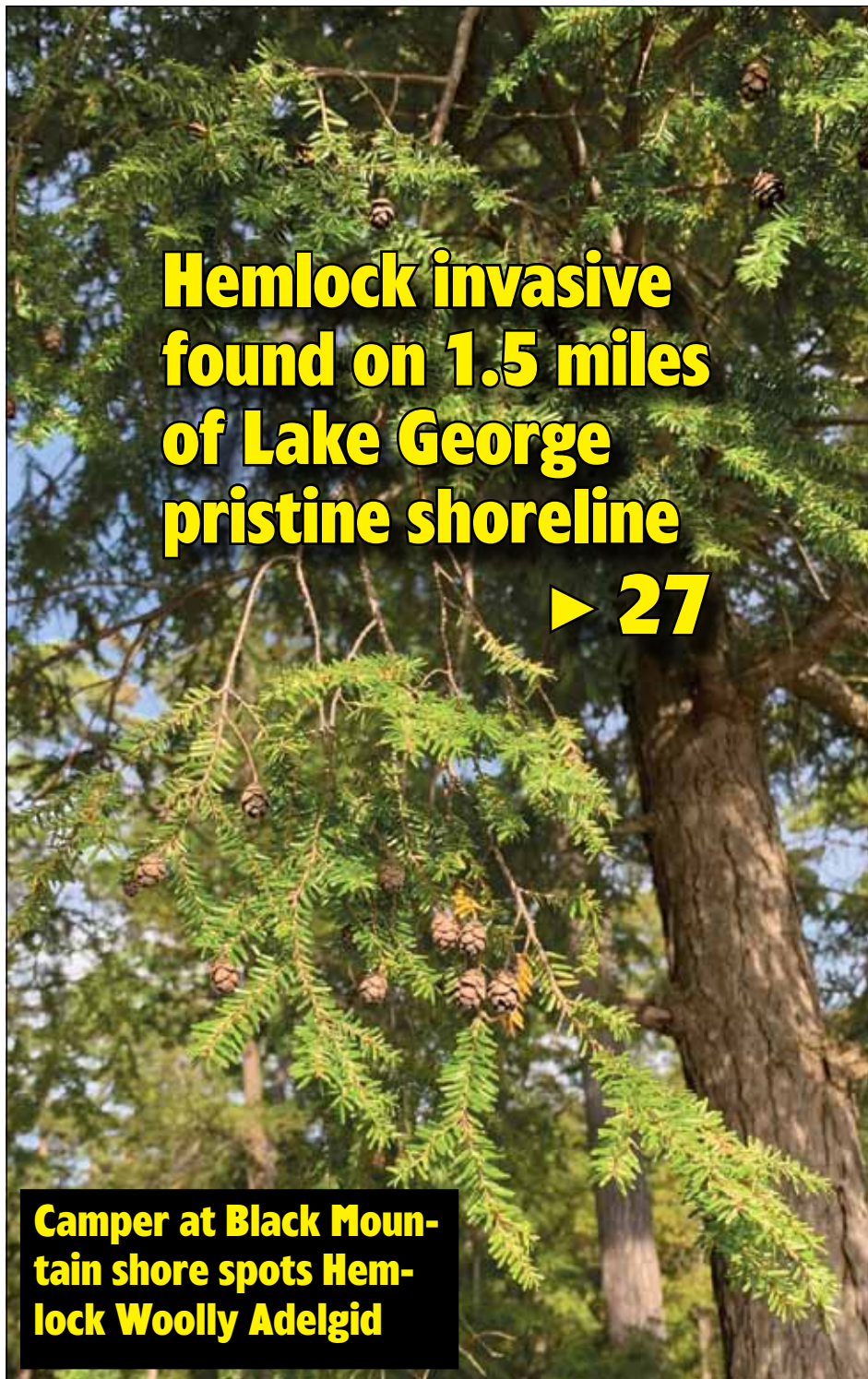

## Blais is blazing mad re non-car show

Lake George Mayor Bob Blais minced no words after cars and crowds jammed the village last weekend

despite pandemic-caused cancellation of the Adirondack Nationals car show.

"A bunch of unruly spectators came to Lake George, bent on seeing a show, basically going to be done by people who came with their muscle cars, encouraging and egging them on and hoping they would see illegal activity."

Saturday night's crowd grew so large, Warren County Sheriff Jim LaFarr reports, he decided to shut the Village down, closing
