

Civil War monument inspires his original research project

"We stood to arms this morning at 3 o'clock. A heavy fog filled

trail of

the atmosphere and shut out all view beyond a few paces."

— John Lovell Cunningham, 118th NYV, Drewry's Bluff VA. May 16th, 1864

In the woods just behind this marker off the old Richmond-Petersburg Turnpike in Bermuda Hundred, Virginia, men from our community, soldiers of the Adirondack Regiment, were killed or wounded in intense fighting during the Civil War.

While soldiers from our area fought in many well-known engagements like Gettysburg, Bull Run and Antietam, they suffered the most casualties in lesser known battles and in the later stages of the War.

May 1864 was the bloodiest month of the Civil War, and it was the bloodiest month for soldiers from upstate New York.

Visiting any of the Civil War battle fields in Virginia invokes a range of emotions. But standing here was different. The emotions much more personal. For this was the location where men from my own community made the ultimate sacrifice. I had undertaken
