

Spartan pride: Stec, Smith & Carusone rise

Three of the area's most prominent elected officials are all members of Queensbury High School's Class of 1987.

Newly elected State Senator Dan Stec, newly elected Warren County Judge Rob Smith and in-

cumbent Warren County District Attorney Jason Carusone graduated together, in a class of 265 students.

"What are the odds?" Mr. Stec wonders, "a D.A., a judge and a senator in the same class?" He also notes, "We represent all three branches of government — I'm legislative; Rob is judicial, Jason is executive branch, that's law enforcement."

Mr. Smith says, "For all three of us to grow up, live in Queensbury your whole life, and come back to represent the people of Queensbury, and beyond, that's

really something unique."

"It was just a great group of people," Mr. Carusone concurs. "There were a lot of sharp kids in that class, many high achievers. A lot of them remained local. It's a nice statement about the area that so many want to stay and be a part of things here."

Stolen identity internet fraud

It started with a mailing this fall from KeyBank to my name and our business street address: "Dear Mark E. Frost: Thank you for opening your new Key Smart Checking Account with Key Bank."

I had not opened a Key Smart Checking Account or any other account with Key Bank. Ever.

I thought it was a come-on. I thought to myself: Can they still do stuff like this?

More mailings followed. One was a statement that showed a zero balance in the account. Only the last four digits of the account number were shown. I didn't understand what was going on.

Then in late October came a thick envelope. Hand-written were my name and address. The return address was a stick-on label that said KeyBank Fraud Hotline. There was no KeyBank logo anywhere.

Inside a six-page pre-printed form was headlined Identity Theft Victim's Complaint and Affidavit. Among other things, I was sup-
