



Prince Harry's key role

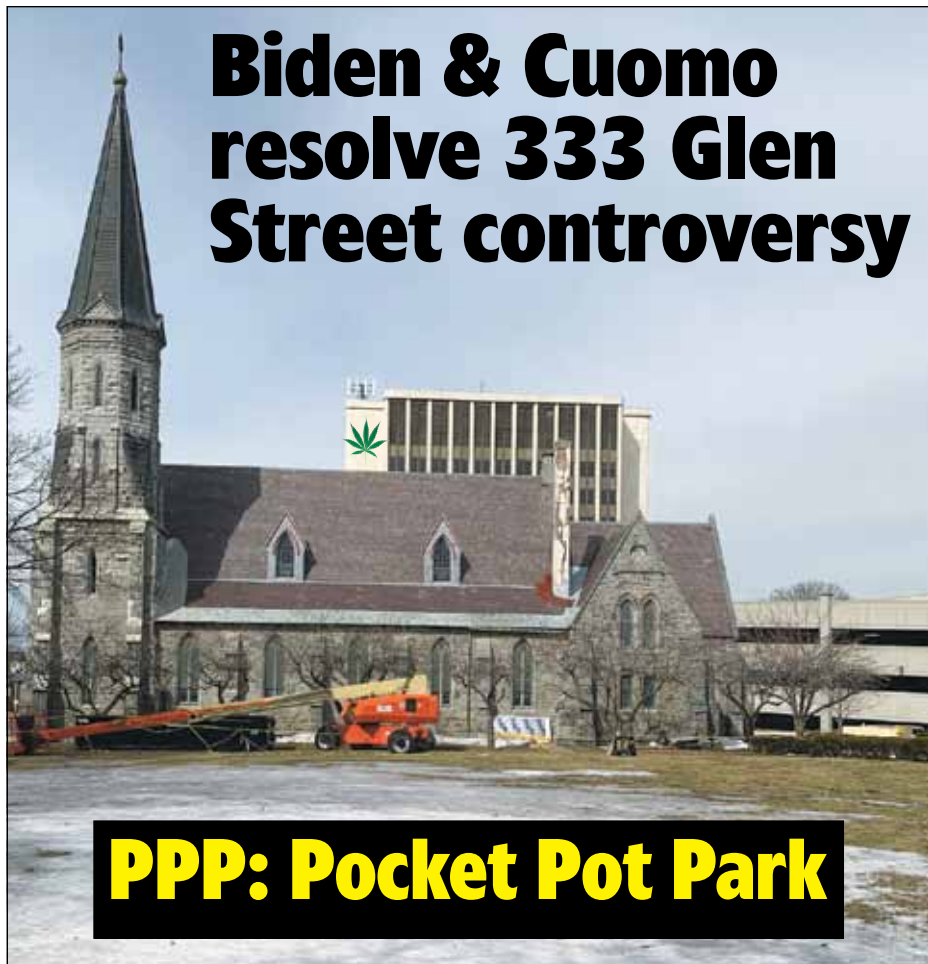
Prince Harry, President Biden and Governor Andrew Cuomo have stepped in to solve Glens Falls's fiercest controversy this century — whether to save or develop the greenspace at the intersection of Glen and Bay Streets.

The heated dispute is what drew the interest of Harry, Duke of Sussex, younger son of the late Princess Diana. really have an impact on there."

Harry phoned Mayor Dan Hall. "At first I didn't believe it was him," Mr. Hall told *The Chronicle* "but when Meghan Markle got on the phone, she's very persuasive."

Mr. Hall referred Prince Harry to Governor Cuomo, who explained that he was busy legaliz-

ing marihuana. That gave rise to Harry's idea for the PPP: Pocket Pot Park, which will save the green space but generate enormous tax revenue for everyone.

Queen Latifah said JUST Water will introduce JUST WEED, from organic marijuana grown on the mountain in Queensbury where

Coincidentally, JUST Water's former Chief Operating Officer Jim Sip-lon now heads Warren County's Economic Development Corporation.

U.S. Senator Chuck Schumer said Chris Patten, who planned to erect apartments on the site, "will be made whole," receiving \$9-million of stimulus money.

"C'mon man. We can probably shake loose a couple hundred thousand dollars more, if it comes to that," Pres. Biden said.

Prince Harry said, "I talked to President Biden — and he told me that Glen Falls once was Hometown, U.S.A., maybe I can help make it be Hometown, U.S.A. again."

"It will be a tremendous tourist attraction," said Mayor Bob Blais. "And we'll use it as our fireworks platform."

Its containers can be emergency lodging. Lake George Steamboat President Bill Dow said, "It's a big boat. Nothing we can't handle."

"We'll use it for research," said FUND for Lake George chairman Jeff Killeen.
