But, on a small but real scale, contends **Bill Richmond**, "Diverting your food waste from the trash stream and creating compost that helps retain moisture and carbon in the soil is the most impactful thing individuals can do."

In the past 18 months, Mr. Richmond says his **Adirondack Worm Farm in Hudson Falls** has collected 5 tons of food waste from area residents and the cafeteria at St. Mary's-St. Alphonsus Regional Catholic School.

"Our service takes food waste that can't be composted in backyards, including meat and dairy,

"Privilege of the Floor" comments at the end of the meeting triggered a 40-minute brouhaha that included accusations of misogyny and unprofessionalism, earnest pleas to "act like adults," outright abandonment of Robert's Rules of Order — and a little laughter.

The raw exchange exposed alliances and frustrations that cross party, town and gender lines.

Fortunately, the nearly two-hour meeting that preceded it showed that the board does still function. Most notably, it
