Last week I did an item expressing my relief and delight at the annual leafing out of Glens Falls's glorious elm tree on Glen Street at the north edge of the City.

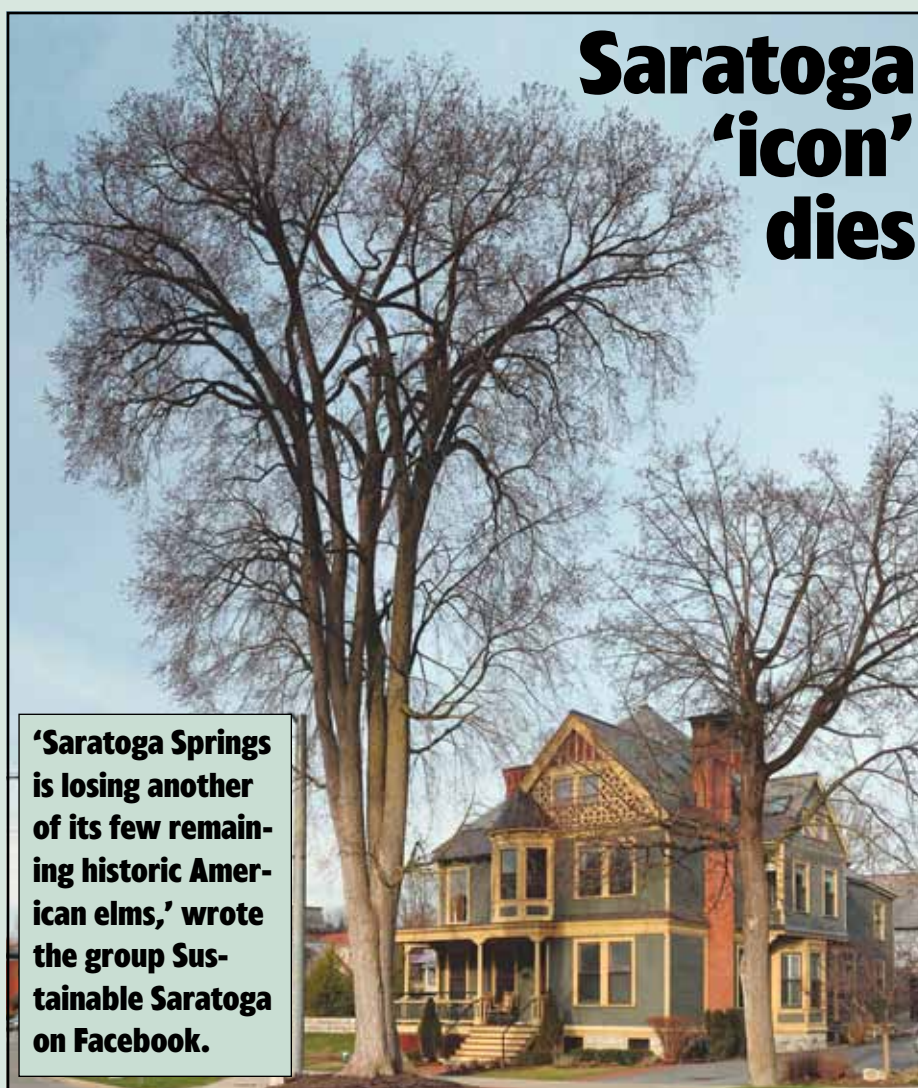
