

Lake George battlefield finally getting own museum

A hundred years as a concept, 20 years in the pursuit, and now with two years of effort and a bit of fortunate happenstance, the Lake George Battlefield Park will finally this summer get a Visitor Interpretive Center and museum. It's expected to open in early summer, on the ground floor of the new Lake George Park Commission headquarters building on Fort George Road.

"They talked about a museum on the site when the park was first created in 1898, says Lynda "Lyn" Hohmann. She heads the Lake George Battlefield Park Alliance, which revived the mu-

Fort Ann Airbnb fight

The Town of Fort Ann is looking to enact short term rental laws that have Airbnb and Vrbo property owners up in arms.

More than 280 people have signed a petition titled "Hands Off Our Homes," opposing short term rental laws, posted on the website www.change.org.

No public meeting has yet been set for the law, but opponents said they aim to attend the next Town Board meeting "to voice our concerns." The next town board meeting is Monday, June 14, at 6 p.m. at the Fort Ann Firehouse.
