Kevin Geraghty, Warrensburg's town supervisor for the past 12 years and a councilman for 16 years before that, faces **Nathan "Bud" York**, who served three terms as Warren County Sheriff from 2008 to 2020, in a battle of proven vote-getters in the June 22 Republican primary.

Democratic town councilman **Rich Larkin** has

his spot already on the Nov. 2 general election ballot.

The real estate price, for the full-service marina at 34 Sagamore Road and associated property on Edgecomb Pond Road, was \$3.013-million, indicates the Warren County real estate filing.
