The big enchilada, of course, is the Queensbury At-Large race for Warren County Supervisor. It's like the old game Musical Chairs. Four seats, five candidates. When the music stops on Nov. 2, one person's eliminated.

Four of the candidates are **incumbent Republicans — Doug Beaty, Brad Magowan, Rachel Seeber and Mike Wild**.

Being both incumbent and Republican typically assures victory in Queensbury, and it might well this time, too.

But **Brent McDevitt, the fifth candidate**, brings some new calculus to the equation. He's a Democrat, but that's not the thrust of his effort. Instead, he's quickly built a high-profile personal brand.

He's running despite a lengthy
