I see a tremendous grass roots victory for Republicans — and a danger alert for the Democrat progressive "woke" agenda.

The marquee match-up was Virginia governor's race. Republicans hadn't won a statewide race in Virginia since 2009. The former "Capital of the Confederacy," is now more of an affluent Washington, D.C. suburb, running reliably blue.
