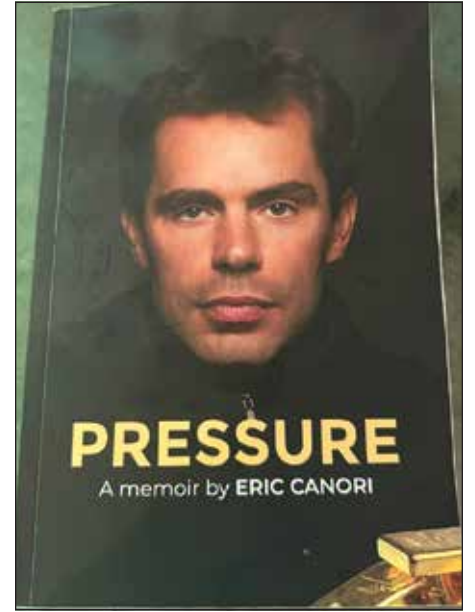

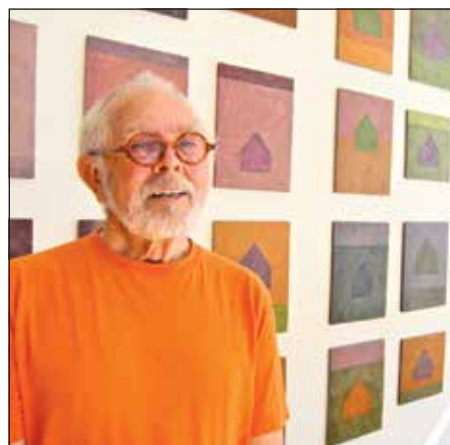
Re Mar-A-Lago raid: It's government document, not souvenir
