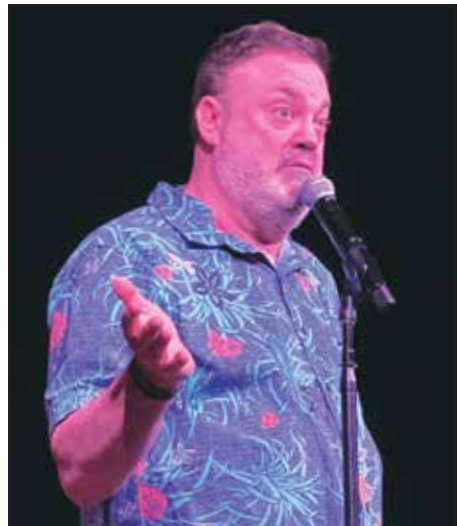

A week before Election Day, so many races appear up for grabs.

On Tuesday, Nov. 1, the day this issue of *The Chronicle* went to press, the Republican-affiliated **Trafalgar Group** said its poll for New York State governor shows a tie, **48% each, for Kathy Hochul and Lee Zeldin.**

But the **Hill Emerson poll** on the same day had **Hochul leading Zeldin by 9, 54%-45%.**
