

Eric Unkauf, owner-redeveloper of the Shirt Factory in Glens Falls, has an ambitious plan to turn the surrounding 5-acre campus he has assembled into a mural garden — officially "Muralgarten."

"It'll be a world-class tourist attraction," Mr. Unkauf tells *The Chronicle*.

He sees it as a year-round draw that will be a "transformational catalyst" for the east side of Glens Falls, the city, Warren County and "the wider region."

He plans to go before the City Planning Board in May, to seek initial approvals for the project,

or portions of it.

"Definitely a destination,"
says local mural artist Hannah Williams, who is working
with Mr. Unkauf on the project

Eric Unkauf enlists local artists, historian; 30 murals, to start, on buildings, fencing, shipping containers along with artists Fred Holman and Tom Myott and retired Chapman Historical Museum director Timothy Weidner. It'll be **open to the public, free**,
