The Warren County Board of Supervisors on May 11 approved a resolution to support merging Greater Glens Falls

Transit with Albany-based CDTA — Capital District Transportation Authority.

"This was the right thing to do," Board Chairman Kevin Geraghty of Warrensburg told *The Chronicle*.


"The City of Glens Falls can no longer do it on its
