Kennys sell Adk. Outlets

The Kenny family has sold its outlet properties including Adirondack Outlet Mall to Sobert Realty Corp. and the Shanus Family, which already owned the nearby The Outlets at Lake George.

Adirondack Outlet Mall, located at 1444 Route 9, sold for \$9-million. 1468 Route 9, an empty building, sold for \$3-million.

Adirondack Outlet Mall is home to L.L. Bean, Under Armour, Timberland, Famous Footwear, Artie's Camping & More, and other retailers.

Stores at The Outlets at Lake George East and West range from Polo Ralph Lauren, Coach and Michael Kors to Columbia, Skechers and Adidas.

"The East and West centers now are fully leased," Sobert President Corey Shanus told The Chronicle Tuesday. "We're trying to bring in good quality brands to Lake George. And we

JG3 scores 25 vs. Pitt; Clemson unbeaten, in top 25

Glens Falls' Joe Girard III delivered his best game yet for the undefeated Clemson Tigers on Sunday, December 3, en route to a 79-70 victory at Pittsburgh. JG3 tallied 25 points

and 2 assists on 7-10 shooting from the field. Teammate PJ Hall added 22 points and 11 rebounds on 9-14 shooting.

It was JG3's highest point total yet for the Tigers. He transferred for his final year of college eligibility after 4 seasons and 125 games for Syracuse.

Last game, JG3 passed

Duke's Jay Williams to be "ninth all-time in ACC history for 3-pointers made (314)," Clemson said.

The Tigers are ranked #23 nationally. Their best win is on the road against then #23 Alabama, 85-77 on November 28.

JG3's hotly anticipated return to Syracuse is Saturday, Feb. 10.
