Tres Mijas, the popular Mexican food truck owned by Mike and Jenna Fernandez of Glens Falls, is opening a brick and mortar location, downtown at **21 Bay Street** in the Rogers Building.

Mike said they'll start as

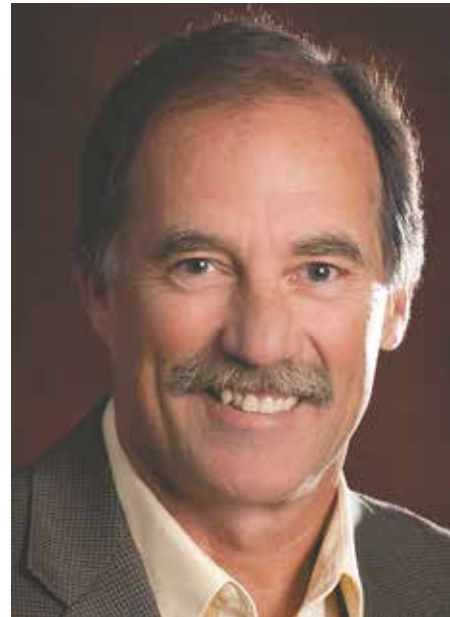
Mike & Jenna Fernandez launched their business in 2022, named for their three daughters; his father is Mexican; she's GF Class of 2005

The name Tres Mijas comes from Mike and Jenna's three daughters — tres, meaning three, and slang combining mi & hijas for "my daughters." Mike said his father Joe is Mexican. Mike grew up in Cali-

fornia until his family moved to Vermont when he was 11. "There was just no Mexican food that we could find," he said. So he says his mom, Brenda, learned everything about Mexican cooking that she could from his grandmother, her mother-in-law. "My mom was a phenomenal cook, just to start with.
