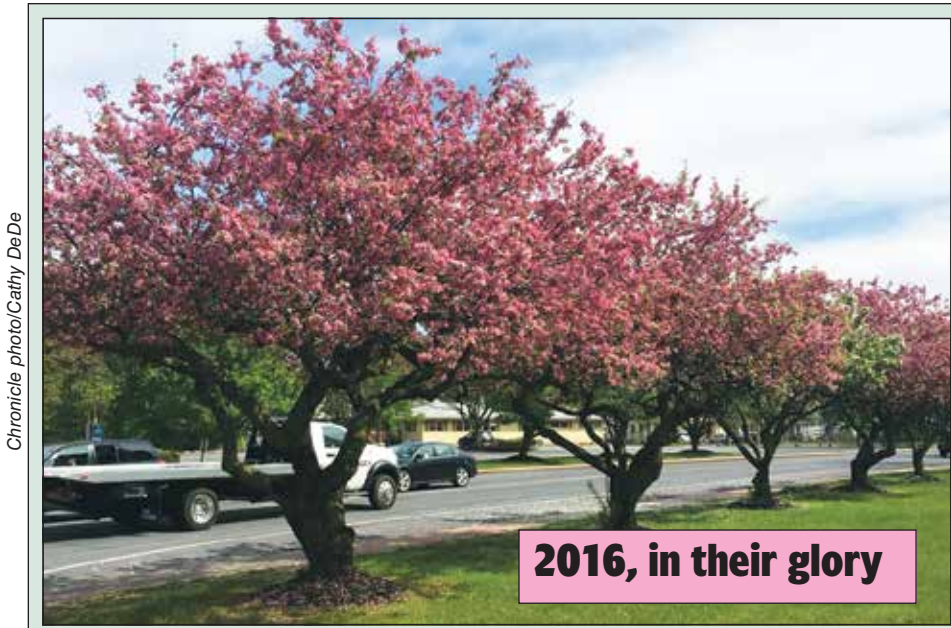

Farewell to ailing crabapples

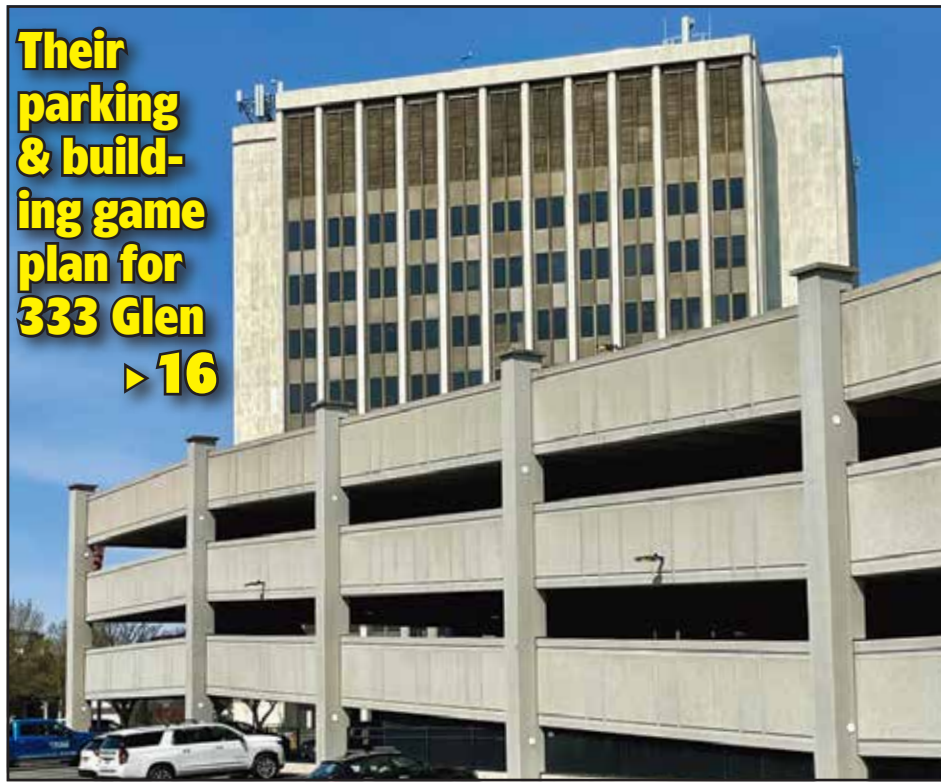

Leash all dogs in Qby. parks

The Queensbury Parks and Recreation Commission announced **new rules for dogs in town parks**, taking effect on **May 1**, "in response to recent incidents and community complaints and prioritizing the safety and enjoyment of all park visitors."

The key requirements of the ordinance include:

- Dogs Must Be Leashed while in town parks.
- Identification Required: Dogs must wear a collar with an ID tag and a valid license.
- Restricted Areas: Dogs are

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
