

## Ground broken: GF Hospital new Emergency Dept.

At a ceremonial groundbreaking Thursday, Glens Falls Hospital President and CEO Paul Scimeca said the Capital Campaign for its Sheridan Emergency Department expansion has raised \$14.3 million of its original \$15 million community contribution goal.

Then he upped the ante by \$2-million. "Not surprisingly," said Mr. Scimeca, "since we first envisioned this project two years ago, some costs have gone up...by about \$2 million." He said the Hospital Foundation Board voted to increase the
