




Shake, Rattle & Roll 'opens soon'

Literally for years, locals and passers-by at one of Queensbury's busiest intersections have watched slow, seemingly uncertain progress of a handsome new restaurant building (and a market building) at the corner of Routes 149 and 9L.

It's **totally the vision of Dale Baldwin**, the Fort Ann concrete contractor who owns this 25-acre property and knows what he wants to do with it. **For one thing it will display some of his colossal collection of auto-oriented antiques**, including signage

The restaurant will serve hamburgers and 'Hound Dog' hot dogs with his "Mother's Meat Sauce") plus french fries and salads. The walk-up ice cream window ranges from cones and sundaes to floats

and banana splits using **ice cream from Schuylerville's King Dairy**.

NYS law cuts local election terms short

Most local towns will elect a supervisor and town council on Nov. 4. Then one year later they'll have to do it again if new state legislation is upheld.

The law mandates that town and some county office elections must move to even-numbered years instead of the current odd-number years.

Democrats enacted the law saying it will increase turn-out having the elections in the same years as the higher profile state and federal elections.

Republicans say it's a ploy to increase Democratic turnout which is greater in those years. Critics also contend it will over-
