The Queensbury Hotel opened for business on May 7, 1926. Today is 100 years later exactly. It's a good moment for us and the hotel to celebrate. Glens Falls is lucky still to have a working hotel at the center of downtown. Not many small towns do.

All the better, the Queensbury is thriving, in part because it has come full circle — launched with local ownership in 1926 and back with local ownership since 2016 after its purchase by entrepreneur Ed Moore.
